KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of the sum of One Dollars, to Tom Yessick and wife Effie Yessick in hand paid by J. W. Lovelady and Gearldine Lovelady the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged we do remise, release, quit claim and convey to the said J. W. Lovelady and Gearldine Lovelady all our right, title, interest and claim in or to the following described real estate, To wit:

Beginning where the north line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, Township 21, Range 3 West crosses the right of way of the Southern Railroad, which point is the northeast corner of the property conveyed to Sam Lit according to Deed recorded in Volume 43 page 40 in the Office of the Probate Judge of Shelby County Alabama; thence west along said line 585 feet more or less, to the Elyton dirt road, also known as Birmingham and Montevallo Road and which point is the northwest corner of the property described in said deed; thence along said road south, 10 degrees west, 649 feet to the point of beginning of the lot herein conveyed; thence north 87 degrees east, 265 feet; thence south and parallel with the east line of said road 155 feet; thence south, 87 degrees west, 265 feet to the east line of said road; thence north along the east line of said road 155 feet to the point of beginning, being situated in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, Township 21, Range 3 West.
