Before me, Mrs. J. W. Donahoo, the undersigned authority in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared J. W. Moore, who, after being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says:

My name is J. W. Moore, I am 68 years of age and have lived in and around Westover, Shelby County, Ala. all of my life. I am familiar with the following described land:

The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, Township 20, Range 1 East, Shelby County, Alabama.

My brother, J. R. Moore purchased said land from Walter Hoffman in March, 1924, He did not live on the land but he went over it from time to time. In fact, I was with him a time or two when he looked over the land and an old house was situated on the land. My said brother did not own the land for many years but sold it to Issac Lee Hayne on May 26, 1926, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 79 Page 186 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, I understand that J. R. Moore did not file for record his deed from Walter Hoffman. This was certainly an oversight on his part because I do know he owned the land and claimed to own it during the years mentioned. J. R. Moore died a few years after May, 1926, when he sold said land to Issac Lee Hayne.

J. R. Moore's wife, Callie Moore, died a short time before his death. I do not know what became of the records and papers they had in their home and so far as I know they have all been destroyed. J. R. Moore did not leave any children living but he did leave a grand daughter who came and lived with me. I feel confident that no one else has J. R. Moore's records or papers.

I have been familiar with the persons owning said land since my brother sold it to Isaac Lee Hayne. I have never heard of J. D. Ware owning or claiming to own said land nor have I heard of J. J. Hightower or M. J. Hightower claiming to own or exerting any ownership over said land.


