Owens for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen and no/100 (\$15.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain electric transmission lines and all telegraph and telephone lines, towers, poles and appliances necessary or convenient in connection therewith from time to time upon, counter-poise wires and/or other counter-poise conductors under, a strip of land Fifty (50) feet in width, as said strip is now located by the final location survey thereof heretofore made by said Company, over and across the lands of which it is hereinafter described as being a part, said survey to determine the boundaries of said strip, together with all rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof for the purposes above described, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said strip and the right to cut and keep clear all trees and undergrowth and other obstruction on said strip and danger trees adjacent thereto which now or may hereafter injure or endanger any of the works on said strip, and the right to install, maintain and use anchors and guy wires on land adjacent to said strip.

Said strip is approximately described as follows: Commence at the NE Corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Tp 22 South, Range 2 West and run South along the East boundary line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9 for a distance of 300 feet to the point of beginning of the right of way herein described; from said point of beginning turn an angle to the right and twenty five (25) feet on each side of center line and the continuations thereof, run North 87° 31' west for a distance of 215 feet to a point on the west boundary line of the grantors land.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns, forever.

The grantors shall have the right to cultivate and use said strip of land for any purpose not inconsistent with the rights which the grantee may from time to time exercise hereunder.
