Cowles, Grace Lyman Clarke, and husband Neal Lamar Clarke, Edward S. Lyman, Jr., an unmarried man, and Grace Lyman Clarke as attorney-in-fact for Hattie Welton Lyman, in hand paid by Lillian K. Ward, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged we do remise, release quit claim and convey to the said Lillian K. Ward all our right, title, interest and claim in or to the following described real estate, to-wit:

A certain lot located in "Lyman's addition" to the town of Montevallo described as follows: Beginning at the NW intersection of Highland Street with the Ashville public road, now known as the Montevallo-Siluria Highway, according to the map and survey of said "Lyman's Addition" as recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, and from said point of beginning run thence southwest along the margin of said Highland Street 116.6 feet to what is known as the T.E.
