## QUIT CLAIM DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of the sum of one Dollars, to Luther Naish and wife, Ethel Naish in hand paid by Floyd Naish the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged we do remise, release, quit claim and convey to the said Floyd Naish all our right, title, interest and claim in or to the following described real estate, to-wit:

Begin at the southwest corner of Section 15, Township 20, Range 3 West and run north, 2 degrees and 10 minutes west, along the west line of said Section 15, 1140 feet to the point of beginning; thence north, 87 degrees and 15 minutes east, 191.3 feet to the northwest corner of Luther Naish lot; thence along the north line of said Luther Naish lot, run south, 88 degrees and 55 minutes east, 477.7 feet to the west line of 3rd Street in the Town of Helena, Alabama; thence along same north, 6 degrees and 55 minutes west, 117.3 feet; thence south, 81 degrees and 45 minutes west, 229 feet; thence north, 47 degrees and 25 minutes west, 114 feet; thence north, 32 degrees and 25 minutes west, 264.7 feet to a fence line, thence along said fence line south, 80 degrees and 35 minutes west, 217.1 feet to the west line of said Section 15; thence along same south, 2 degrees and 10 minutes east, 399 feet to the point of beginning; being situated in the Town of Helena, Shelby County, Alabama.

To have and to Hold to the said Floyd Naish, his heirs and assigns forever.
