I do hereby ratify everything that my said attorney may do, by virtue of the power herein contained. Witness my hand, this the 21st day of April, 1950.

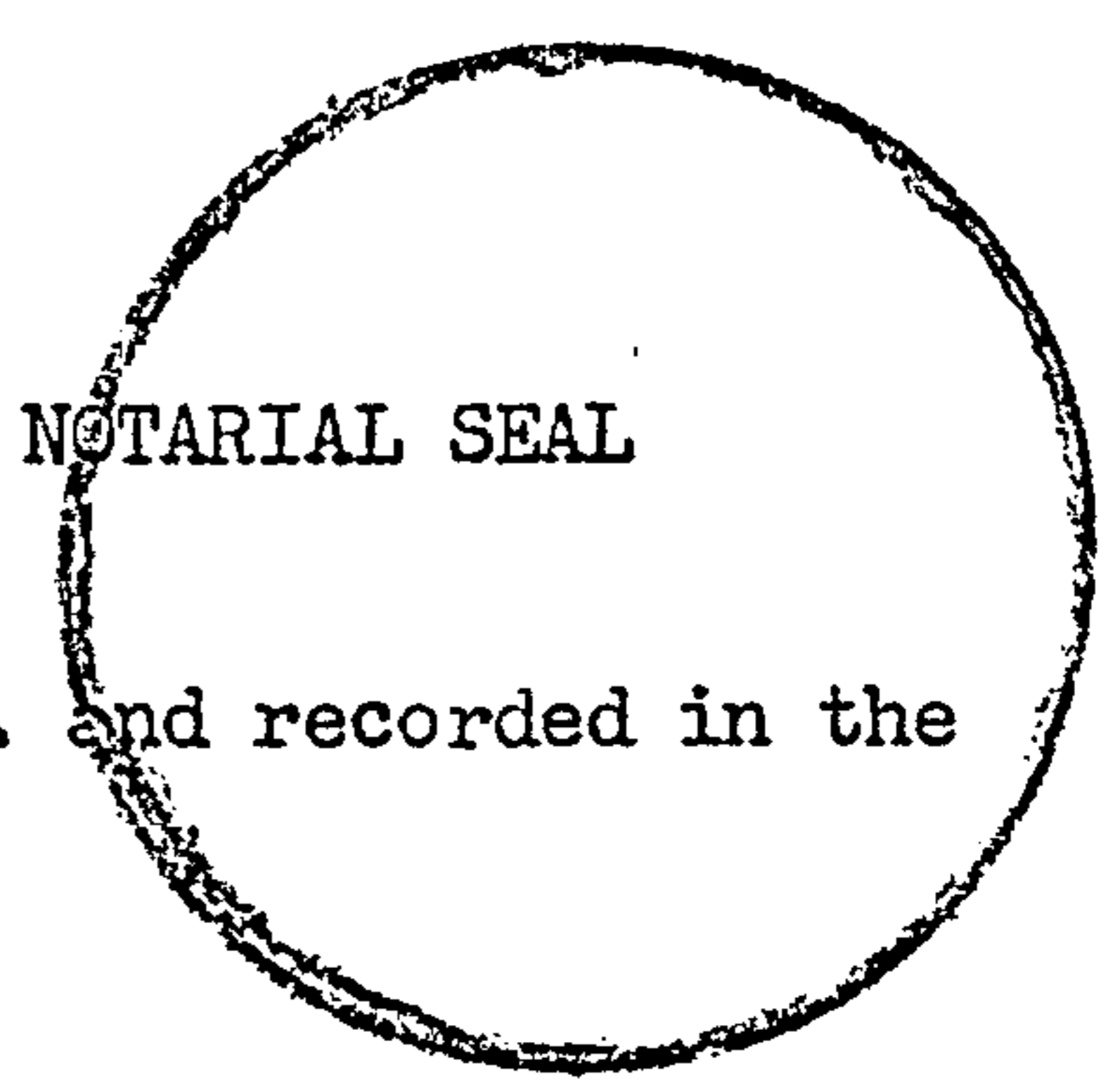
