Campbell the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged we do remise, release, quit claim and convey to the said W.N. Campbell all our right, title, interest and claim in or to the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama to wit:

Beginning at the NE corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, Township 19, Range 3 West and run South along the east line of said section 984 feet to the point of beginning of the tract herein conveyed, thence continue south along the east line of said section 216 feet to the east right of way of the Birmingham-Montgomery Highway, thence northwest along the east line of said highway 265 feet, thence in an easterly direction 240 feet to the point of beginning, and situated in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36 Township 19, Range 3 West.
