Before the undersigned authority personally appeared Mamie Broyles, who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says:

I am acquainted with the S 1/2 of SE 1/4, Section 36, Township 19, Range 2 East, Shelby County, Alabama, and have known said land since January 5, 1918, when I purchased it from V.D. Funchess, et. al. On the last named date deed was executed by V.D. Funchess, et. al, and filed for record in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, on January 16, 1918, and is recorded in Deed Book 63, page 181.

Immediately after the execution of the last named deed I went into possession of the property and had tenants on it cultivating it each and every year until I sold it to W.E. Fuller about the 26th day of November, 1945. Since I procured the deed from V.D. Funchess, et. al. I went into possession of the property and was in actual, open notorious, continuous, exclusive, adverse possession of the property, having it cultivated by tenants until I deeded it to W.E. Fuller.
