My name is Gertrude Heath Elliott, I am a resident of Shelby County, Alabama, and live at Montevallo Alabama.

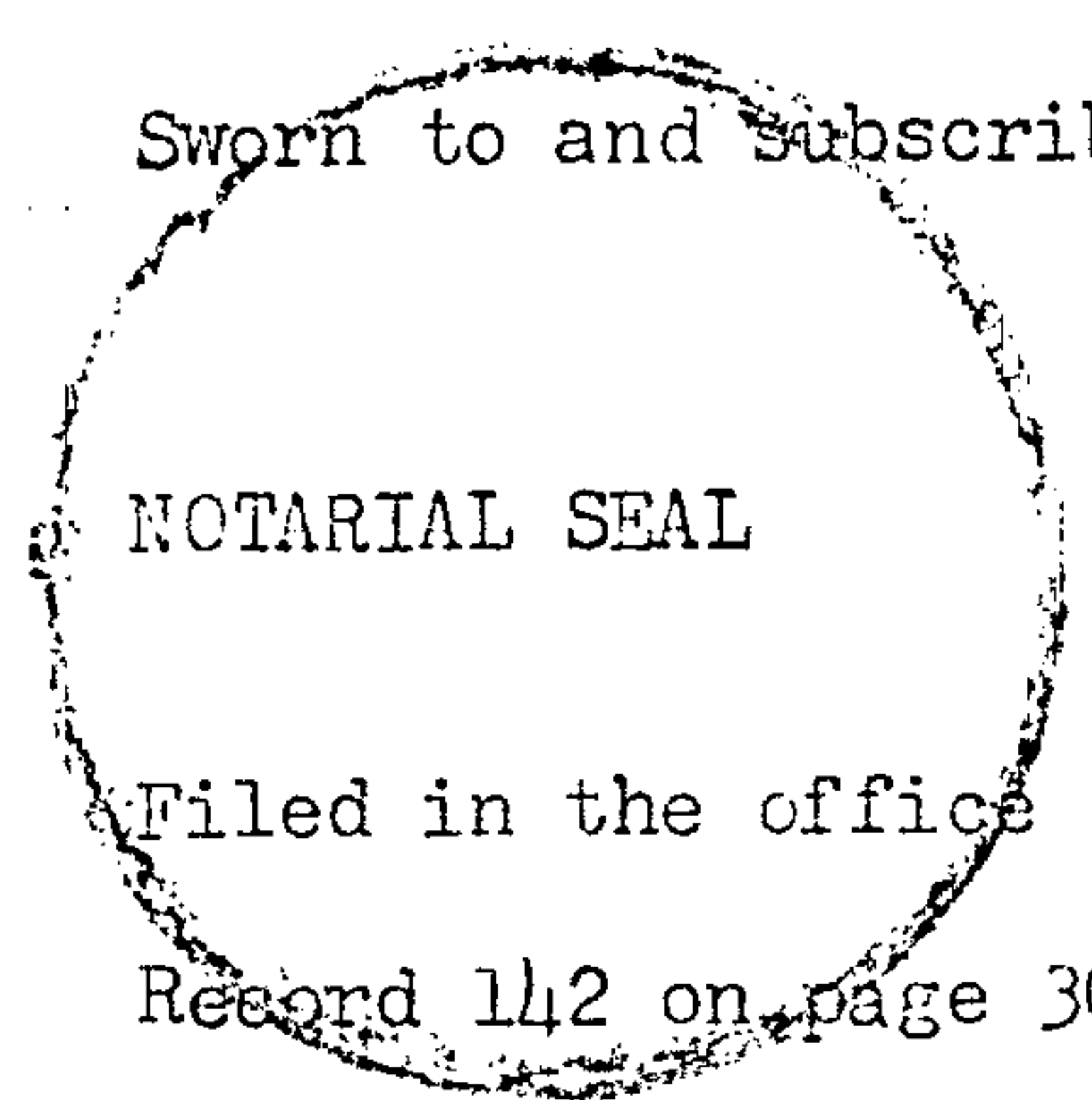
