Gentlemen:

Complying with request from Mr. R.K. Parks, County Engineer, the Shelby County Board of Revenue and Control is hereby granted the right to remove a quantity of clay gravel estimated to be 40,000 cubic yards from the site identified to your representative, Mr. Falkner by our agent, Mr. Richards, on September 1, 1950, located on property of the Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company in the South-West Quarter of Fouth-West quarter of Section 34, Township 21 South, Range 4 West, Shelby County, Alabama, for us in connection with your Road Project in Shelby County, Alabama, upon the following conditions:

- (1) The removal of said clay gravel shall be performed in a manner satisfactory to the Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company and when this work is completed you are to leave the premises in a condition satisfactory to this company.
- (2) The Shelby County Board of Revenue and Control shall protect and save harmless the Tennessee Coal, Iron Company from all loss, damage, cost or expense which it may sustain as a result of this operation.
- (3) The authority herein granted shall become effective on the 8th day of September, 1950, and shall expire on the 30th day of November, 1951, but may be terminated at any time prior to said date upon thirty (30) days' written notice from the Tennessee. Coal, Iron and Railroad Company.
- (4) The Shelby County Board of Revenue and Control shall keep an accurate account of all clay gravel removed from said location and shall pay the Tennesses Coal, Iron and Railroad Company at the rate of Three Cents (3¢) per cubic yard for all clay gravel removed from said location and payment for said clay gravel so removed shall be made on or before December 15, 1951, for all clay gravel removed during the termsof this contract.

This letter is written in duplicate and when one copy is returned to this office with your acceptance endorsed thereon it shall constitute a contract between Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company and Shelby County Board of Revenue and Control.
