Connors, Sr., deceased in hand paid by the Town of Helena, a municipal corporation the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged it does remise, release, quit-claim, and convey to the said Town of Helena, a municipal corporation all its right, title, interest and claim in or to its undivided onesixth interest to the following described real estate (or, land), to-wit:

Begin at a point on the section line on the north edge of Buck Creek, a distance of 31 chains and 48 links south of the northeast corner of Section 15, Township 20, Range 3 West; thence westerly along the edge of Buck Creek to a point opposite the mouth of the Cobb Spring Branch thence along said Spring branch to its intersection with the Mattie M. Leonard Tract; thence due east along the north boundary of said Mattie M. Leonard tract to Prairie Branch; thence along Prairie Branch to the railroad; thence easterly along said railroad to the said section line; thence north to the point of beginning; containing $45\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less, except the right of way for the L & N or S & N. A. Railroad Company.
