Page, who, being duly sworn deposes and says that he resides at Columbiana, Alabama; that for a period of more than fifty years, last past, he has been acquainted with the location, boundaries, use, owners, and parties in possession of the following described tract of land situated in the Town of Columbiana, Shelby County, Alabama, to wit:

A tract of land commencing where the West line of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 25, Township 21, Range 1 West crosses the South line of Cross Street, or Carter's Land, and being the street running East from North Main Street running from the property formerly known as the W.B. Brown residence, and now known as the Myra V. Chandler residence, in an Easterly direction to Columbiana public school, intersecting Thompson Street, and running thence East along the Southern line of Carter's Land, or Cross Street, a distance

of 50 feet to point of beginning of the lot herein described: Run thence in an Easterly direction along the South margin of Cross Street, or Carter's Lane, a distance of 105 feet; run thence in a Southern direction and parallel with the West line of said last named 40 acres, a distance of 221.5 feet; run thence in a Westerly direction and parallel with Cross Street, or Carter's Lane, as aforesaid, a distance of 105 feet; run in a Northerly direction and parallel with the West line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 25, a distance of 221.5 feet to point of beginning, and being the lot now known as the Robert C. Affiant further says that the West 86.5 feet of the above described lot camethrough the Estate of "obert J. Weaver, his heirs at law conveyed the same to E.L. Garrett; and E.L. Garrett, in 1900, conveyed the same to James H. Page, being the one and same persons as J.H. Page, who was the father of your affiant; that on September 26th, 1900, James H., Page and wife, conveyed the last described lands to Virginia A. Richardson, the daughter of James H. Page and wife, M.D. Page, Virginia A. Page being one and the same person as Addie Richardson, and that soon thereafter Addie Richardson and husband conveyed the West 86.5 feet, and other lands, to J.B. Lecroy, and that the said J.B. Lecroy, later, conveyed said lands to J.W.S. Wolfe; in 1913 said lands were conveyed under a foreclosure deed to Sallie Moore, and on April 11, 1914, affiant says that Sallie Moore, who was then a widow, conveyed said lands to J.W. Morrow.

Affiant further says that the East 18.5 feet of the tract of land described in the second paragraph of this affidavit, was conveyed by Phoebe L. Weaver to her daughter, P. Ella Bailey, who was formerly P. Ella Weaver, and who later married John Booker.

Affiant further says that of his own personal knowledge he knows that for fifty years, last past, that Robert C. Foster and wife, Roxie M. Foster, and those through whom the said Robert C. Foster and wife, Roxie M. Foster hold title, namely, R.F. Lyon, A.R. Looney, A.R. Cooper, Ella Bailey Booker, P. Ella Bailey, A.R. Looney, J.W. Moorow, Sallie Moore, J.W.S. Wolfer, J.B. Lecroy, Addis Richardson, Virginia A. Richardson and James H. Page, respectively, to the above described tract of land, have been, repsectively, in the open, notorious, continuous, peaceable, adverse possession of said tract of land, claiming the same as their own, respectively, against all the world, and regularly and continuously exercising acts of ownership over said lands and using and occupying the same as a house site, and affiant has never heard the title of the said Robert C. Foster and wife, Roxie M. Foster, and those through whom they hold title to said lands, to be questioned by any one.
