WHEREAS, Blanton Moore of Shelby County, Alabama, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United
States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa, whereby it appears that full payment
has been made by the said Blanton Moore according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 2hth of April,
1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for the Northeast quarter
of the Northwest quarter, the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter and the East half of the Southeast
quarter of Section mineteen and the South half of the southwest quarter of Section Twenty and the Northwest
quarter of the North west quarter of Section twenty nine, and the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter
of section thirty in Township Twenty of dange one West, in the district of lands subject to the sale at
Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing three hundred and nineteen acres, and twenty nine hundredths of an acre,
according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the
Surveyor General, which said tracts have been purchased by the said Blanton Moore,

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, Have Given and Granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Blanton Moore and to his heirs, the said tracts above described: To Have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Blanton Moore, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
