

AFFIDAVIT

Before the undersigned authority personally appeared C.N. Shucraft, who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says:

On the 6th day of January, 1933, W.W. Lewis and wife, Mary Lewis deeded to me the following property situated in Shelby County, Alabama, viz:

S $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, Township 21, Range 1 East.

Also, that part of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, Township 21, Range 1 East, that lies West of the Montgomery dirt road, being in all 30 acres, more or less.

On that same date I executed a mortgage back to Mr. Lewis to secure the purchase price of the land. The mortgage was for \$900.00, evidenced by notes payable in installments.

On the 29th day of April, 1933, I deeded this property back to Mr. Lewis in satisfaction of the mortgage and notes, which were delivered to me and were destroyed. They were destroyed because they were paid and were of no further value.
