KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 Dollars, to James T. Black, an unmarried man in hand paid by D.E. Morris the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I do remise, release, ^{or} quit claim and convey to the said D.E. Morris all my right, title, interest and claim in/to the following described real estate, to-wit:

All that part of the $\frac{N_1}{2}$ of the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 19, Range 2 East lying North of Ala. State Highway # 91 known as the Fla. Short Route except the following lot to wit: Commencing at a concrete post #421 on Ala. highway # 91 known as Fla. Short Route and run in a Westerly direction along the Northern boundary of the right of way of said highway 970 feet to an iron stob which is point of beginning of lot herein described; turn thence an angle of 90° to the right and run in a Northerly direction 210 ft; turn thence an angle 90° to the left and run in a Westerly direction 210 ft; turn thence an angle of 90° left and run 210 ft. to said highway; run thence in an Easterly direction along North boundary of said highway 210 ft. to point of beginning said lot being situated in the $\frac{N_1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 19, Range 2 East and containing one acre more or less, situated in Shelby County, Alabama.
