Containing 18 acres, more or less. Also, all of that part of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 34, Township 19, Range 1 East, situated South and Southeast of the Weldon and Harpersville public road. Containing one acre, more or less. Situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

This deed is executed for a nominal consideration for the purpose of clearing title to the land herein described.
