> A strip of land 3 feet wide off the west side of the lot hereinafter described; the west line of said strip of land being 2 feet east of the east curb line on Thompson Street; said lot on which said strip of land is located being described as follows: Begin at a point on the East side of Thompson Street and on the south line of Section 24, Township 21, Range 1 West and running north along the east line of Thompson Street to the south line of Sterrett Street, continue thence east along the south line of Sterrett Street; continue to the east line of an alley running north and south along the east line of the SW_4 of the SW_4 of said Section 24; thence south along the east line of said alley to the SW corner of said forty acres; thence west along the south line of said 40 acre tract to the point of beginning and being all of that party of the said SW2 of Sw3 of Section 24, Township 21, Range 1 West that lies east of Thompson Street and south of Sterrett Street, if said street were continued east from Thompson Street; being situated in Columbiana, Shelby County, Alabama;

to be used by the party of the second part, its successors and assigns for the purposes named, and for such purposes named, and for such purposes only, as are incidental to the construction, maintenance, operation, including any connection lines thereto with the right to lay the same from said line to Thompson Street, and removal of said pipe. It is understood and agreed that any pipes layed across said land will be put eighteen inches or more under the ground, and all ditching and refilling will be done in a workmanlike manner.
