WHEREAS, William Kelly of Shelby County, has deposited in the General Land office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full/payment has been made by the said William Kelly according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 2hth April 1820, entitled "An act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands for the South East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Fifteen in Township Twenty one of Range one East in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama containing thirty nine acres, and ninety five and three quarters hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said William Kelly.

NOW KNOWNYE, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such cases made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said William Kelly and to his heirs, the said tract above described.

To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said William Kelly and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Andrew Jackson, President of the United States of America, have caused these Tetters to be made fatent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the fourth day of November, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and thirty four and of the Independence of the United States the fifty ninth.
