TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, James B. Watters of Shelby County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said James B. Watters according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands" for the West half of the South East quarter of Section fifteen in Township Twenty one of Range one East in the District of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing seventy nine acres and ninety one and a half hundredths of an acre, according to the official plant of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said James B. Watters.

NOW KNOW YE, that the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said James B. Watters and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I Martin Van Buren, President of the United States of America, have caused these Letters to be made Patents and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the thirtieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven and of the Independence of the United States the sixty first.
