Said property is described as follows:

Johnston's Addition to Columbiana, Shelby County, Alabama, said map being recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, on the 10th day of July, 1924, in map book of said office. Said survey having been made by J.D. Moor, C.E. Leeds, Alabama, Said property being described more particularly as follows: Pegin at the northwest corner of Section 25, Township 21, Range 1 West, Shelby County, Alabama, and run south, 73 degrees and 35 minutes east, 635 feetto the northwest corner of the W.F. Payne tract of land on the east line of Thompson Street; Thence run along the east line of said street south, 18 degrees and 30 minutes east, 169 feet to the point of beginning; Thence run North 75e degrees and 15 minutes west, 140 feet to said east line of Thompson street; thence run south, 75 degrees and 15 minutes west, 140 feet to said east line of Thompson street; thence run north, 18 degrees and 30 minutes west, 100 feet to the point of beginning.
