WHEREAS, George Harding, of Shelby County, Alabama, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said George Harding, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making furtherprovisions for the sale of the Public Lands", for the North half of the Northeast quarter, of Section Five in Township Eighteen of Range One Last, and the West half of the Southeast Quarter and the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section Thirty two in Township Seventeen of Range One East, in the district of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama, containing one hundred and ninety nine acres and sixty nine and a half hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plat of the Survey of said Lands, returned to the General Land office by the Surveyor General, which said tracts have been purchased by the said George Harding.

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said George Harding and to his heirs, the said tracts above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said George Harding, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
