Commence at the Southeast corner of the West Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 34, Township 20
South, Range 3 West, and run in a Westerly direction along the South line of Section 34,818 feet to a point; thence turning an angle of 71 degrees 01 minutes to the right and run in a Northwesterly direction 65 feet to a point; thence turning an angle of 1 degree 30 minutes to the right and running in a Northwesterly direction 1267.7 feet, more or less, to a point, which point is at the intersection of Southern Natural Gas Company's existing pipe line and the North right of way line of the Hellena-Alabaster county road, which is the point of beginning of the tract of land herein conveyed.

Thence turning an angle of 98 degrees 26 minutes to the right and run in an Easterly direction and along the North right of way line of said county road 85 deet to a point;

Thence turning an angle of 93 degrees 33 minutes to the left and running in a Northerly direction and parallel to Southern Natural Gas Company's existing pipe line 100 feet to a point;

Thence turning an angle of 86 degrees 27 minutes to the left and running in a Westerly direction and parallel with the North right of way line of said county road 100 feet to a point;

Thence turning an angle to the left 93 degrees 33 minutes and running in a Southerly direction and parallel with Southern Natural Gas Company's existing pipe line 100 feet, more or less, to a point in the North right of way line of said county road;

Thence turning an angle of 86 degrees 27 minutes to the left and running in an "asterly direction along the North right of way line of said county road 15 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, and containing 0.23 acres, more or less.
