TAX DEED

STATE OF A LABAMA,

Shelby CCUNTY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, Whereas, the land hereinafter described was subject to taxation for the year, 1946, and the Board of Revenue levied taxes thereon for county purposes for said year-, and

Whereas, Said land was returned for taxation by Ownere Unknown #4 for said year --; and

WHEREAS, The certificate of assessment was made in accordance with Section 2156 of the ode; and taxes, fees and charges due thereon for said year—and delivered said Docket to the Probate Judge; and reported, in accordance with Section 2268 of the Code, that he was unable to collect said taxes without sale of said land; and

WHEREAS, The Probate Court at the May 1947 Term, rendered decree ordering sale of said land for the payment of said taxes, fees, charges, costs and expenses of sale: and

WHEREAS, The Tax Collector, in enforcement of said; decree, gave theirty days notice by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in Shelby County Democrat, a newspaper regularly published in said County, and also by posting notice at the Court House of said County, and at a public place in the precinct in which the land was situated, that he would sell said land on the 23rd day of June, 1947 between 100 cock A.M. and 4 o'clock P.M., in front of said Court House, which notices described said land and stated the amount forwhich the Probate Court's decree had been rendered against same, and that said taxes had been assessed to where unknown #4; and

WHERFAS, The Tax Collector at said time, in front of said Court House door, did offer said land at public outcry, so that, as far as practicable, only such portion thereof was sold as was necessary to satisfy said decree, and did sell said land to S. P. Splawn, who was the highest bidder, for \$11.86 which covered the taxes, fees, charges, costs and expenses of sale which amount he paid to said Tax Collector; and

WHERFAS, The Tax Collector did then deliver to said purchaser, in accordance with Section 2285 of the Code, a Certificate of Purchase, containing description of said land, showing the date the same had been assessed to Owner Unknown #4 for said year--. and also showing the taxes due thereon, distinguising the amounts due the State and County, and for school purposes, and the fees and costs; and further showing the time for which said land was advertised, the date it was offered for sale, the name of the purchasers, and the price paid; and

WHERFAS, The time for redemption of said land has elapsed, and said Certificate of Purchase has been returned to the Probate Judge by S. P. Splawn, the purchaser (assignee thereof by endorsement which appears legally executed on said Certificate);

NOW, THEREFORE, I.L. C. Walker as Probate Judge in and for said County, in said State, under and by virtue of the provisions of Section 2296 of the Code of Alabama of 1907, and in consideration of one dollar, to me paid, have this day granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto S. P. Splawn all the right, title and interest of said Owner unknown #4 and all the right, title, interest and claim of the said State and County on account of said taxes, or under said decree, in and to the following described land. to-wit: Lots 12, 13, 14, Nabor's Survey of Wilton, Alabama situated in said County and State; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, the said right, title and interest unto said S. P. Splawn heirs, assigns or successors forever; but no right title of interest of any reversioner or remainderman in said land is conveyed hereby.
