Starting at the NW corner of the $SW_{\frac{1}{4}}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of the $NW_{\frac{1}{4}}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Section 1h, Township 21, Range 2 West and running east 1088 feet; thence 20 feet South for beginning point at zime road leading South from Saginaw cut off road; thence 150 feet west; thence 535 feet South; thence 135 feet east to road running south; thence 535 feet North to beginning point, containing 2 acres more or less except the saw mill road on the South side which is to be kept open as a road.

In the event it becomes necessary or desirable for Alabama Power Company to move its lines of poles, towers and appliances in connection with the construction or improvement of any public roads or highway in promixity to its said power lines, the said Company is hereby granted the right to relocate its said lines of poles, towers and appliances on lands of grantors hereinabove described, provided, however, the said Companh shall relocate its said line of poles or towers at a distance not greater than ten feet outside the boundary of the right of way of any such public road or highway as established or re-established from time to time.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.
