My husband and I signed and ackowledged that certain warranty deed that was executed on 13 October 1947 by Annie McLane Harper and husband, Richardl. Harper; Etheleen McLane Payne and husband, John O. Payne; Ruby McLane Shaw and husband, Pharris B. Shaw; and Kitty McLane Shaw and husband, Cecil H. Shaw, to Charles H. McLane, which deed was filed for record and is recorded in Deed Book 131, page 522, of the records of the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama. I have long been known to many people as Kitty McLane Shaw, and I inadvertently signed this deed as Kitty McLane Shaw, though I was given by my parents the Christian name, Kathleen. My parents did not have any other daughter who was named Kathleen, except me. I am quite familiar with the property that was conveyed by the deed described above. My father remained in possession of this land until his death, and since that time it has been continuously in the possession of his heirs and their grantees. This land has never been in the possession of Omer Brasher, now has any claim ever been asserted by or through him to this land. The possession of this land by my father, by his heirs and by their grantees and those claiming through them has been continuous, exclusive, open, notorious, and adverse, or hostile from 24 August 1914 to the date of this affidavit.
