Dear Sir:

Complying with request from your County Enginer, Mr. R. K. Parks, you are hereby authorized to remove a quantity of sand clay estimated to be 12,000 cubic yards from a pit on property of Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company in the South-West quarter of the North-East quarter of Section 10, Township 20, South, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Tabama, upon the following conditions:

- (1.)) The removal of said sand clay shall be performed in a manner satisfactory to the Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company and when this work is completed you are to leave the premises in a condition satisfactory to this company.
- (2). The Board of Revenue and Control of Shelby County shall protect and save harmless the Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad company from all loss, damge, cost or expense which it may sustain as a result of this operation.
- (3) The authority herein granted shall become effective on the 1st day of February, 1951, and shall expire on the 30th day of September, 1951, but may be terminated at any time prior to said date upon thirty (3) days' written notice from the Tennessee Coal Iron and Railroad Company.
- (4) The Board of Revenue and Control of Shelby County shall keep an accurate account of all and clay removed from said location and shall pay the Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company at the rate of Three Cents (3¢) per cubic yard for all sand clay removed from said location and payment shall be made on or before October 15, 1951, for all sand clay removed during the terms of this contract.

This letter is written in duplicate and when one copy is returned to thisoffice with your acceptance endorsed thereon it shall constitute a contract between the Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railred Company and the Board of Revenue and Ontrol of Shelby County, Alabama.
