Before the undersigned authority personally appeared L. B. Green who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn desposes and says:

I am acquainted with 4 acres of land, more or less, situated in $NW_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ OFNW of Section 4, Township 20, Range 1 East, in Shelby County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the SW corner of the NW¹/₄ of NW¹/₄ of Section 4, Township 20, Range 1 East, and running East 390, thence North 530 feet, thence west 390 feet, thence south 530 feet to the point of beginning.

B. H. Green and I purchased this land at Register's sale on the 11th day of October, 1932, and J. M. Leonard, Jr., R gister of the Circuit Court of Shelby County, Alabama, in Equity, executed to us a register's deed conveying said property to us, which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 95 at Page 39.

I conveyedmy interest in this property to B. H. Green by deed dated November 20, 1933, which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelb y County, Alabama, in Deed Book 94 at Page 172 and thereafter I executed to said B. H. Green a deed of correction which deed was executed on the 23rd day of April, 1934, and is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 94 at Page 277.

Said B. H. Green and I entered into possession of said property immmediately after execution of said register's deed aforesaid and remained in actual, open, notorious, continuous, exclusive, adverse possession of same cultivating portions of said land conveyed to us in said register's deed or having the same cultivated continuously until I deeded my interest to Said B. H. Green and thereafter said B. H. Green remained in actual, open, notorious, continuous, exclusive, adverse possession of same, cultivating portions thereof or having portions thereof cultivated continuously until he deeded it to Elbert Miller and wife, Bessie Miller by deed dated July 2, 1946, which deed is recorded in the Probate office of Shelbby County, Akbama, in deed book 125 satpage 143.
