That the parties of the first part, in consideration of One dollar and other good and valuable consideration paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the second part, his successors and assigns, forever, the right to use that certain lie well situated on the east line of the following described lot and being approximately 125 feet north of the Columbiana Road. Said lot being described as folbws:

All that part of the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $E\frac{1}{2}$ of $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of section 17 Township 21 Range 2 West which lies north of the Columbiana, Road; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama

together with the right to insert water pumps or other mechanical devices in said well for the purpose of obtaining water therefrom; provided however, that said well is to be used jointly by the persons owning the above described lot, & persons owning the lot adjoining the east side thereof.

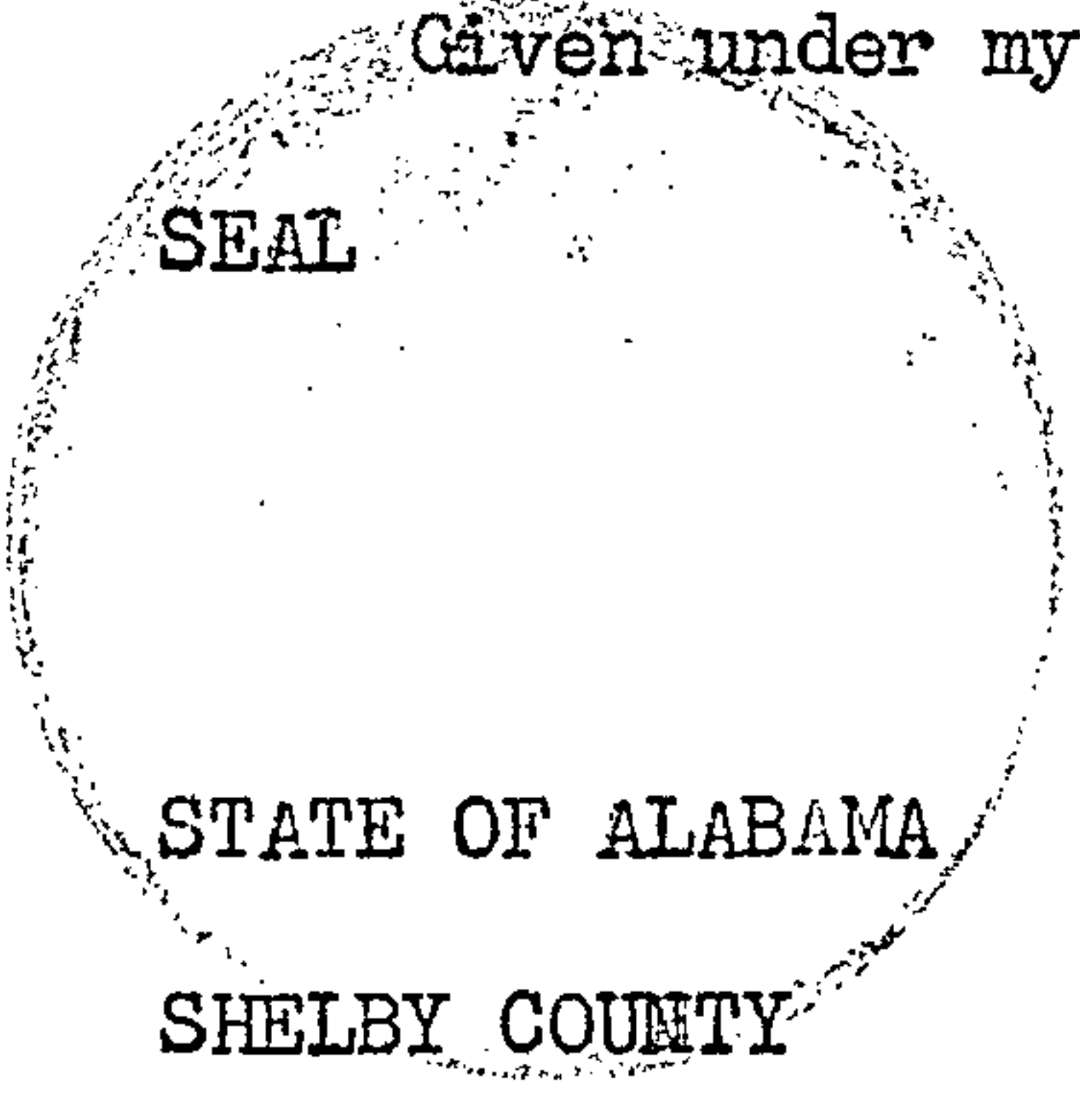

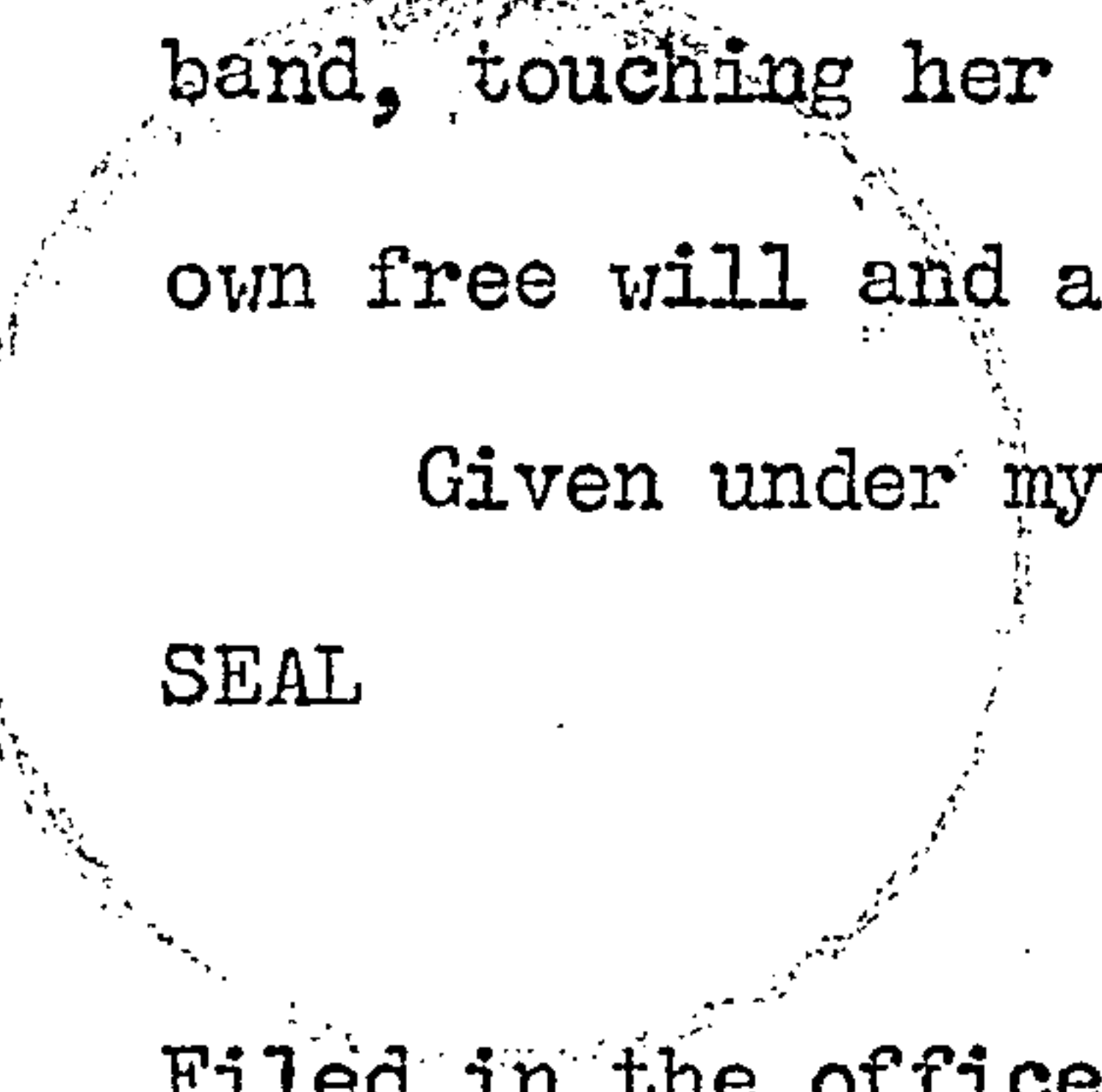
