KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, WHEREAS, Alabama State Land Company did heretofore executed and deliver to Plantation Pipe Line Company three certain instruments dated October 6, 1941, giving and granting unto said grantee certain rights with respect to the construction, operation and maintenance of pipe lines, one of each of said three grants respectively covering lands in Shelby, Bibb and Jefferson Counties in the State of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, each of said grants contained the following provision:

"Grantor, for the same consideration hereinabove expressed, and which has been paid by Grantee to Grantor, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey, subject to all of the terms and provisions hereof, unto Grantee, the right, hereafter and from time to time, to construct, maintain, operate, alter, repair, remove, change the size of and replace within the confines of said easement or right ofway an additional pipe line or lines, the ame to be used for the same purposes as said initial pipe line hereinabove referred to, and each such additional pipe line or lines not to exceed in capacity said initial pipe line, upon the condition, however, that said additional pipe lineor lines shall be constructed adjacent to, and at a distance not to exceed ten (10) feet from the center line of said initial pipe line".

and

WHEREAS, the undersigned are now the owners of the lands covered by said grants; and
WHEREAS, Plantation Pipe Line Company desires to lay an additional pipe line in accordance with the
authority granted under the above quoted provision contained in each of said grants, but desires that the
aid additional line shall be 18 inches in diameter instead of 1h inches in diameter, which is the size of the
present existing pipe line; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned do consent that the said additional pipe line so to be laid may be 18 inches in diameter instead of 14 inches:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of other valuable considerations in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned do hereby consent and agree that the additional pipe line to be constructed by Plantation Pipe Line Company across lands covered by each of the three instruments described above may be 18 inches in diameter instead of 14 inches in diameter.

Except as herein expressly modified, each of said prior instruments shall remain in full force and effect.
