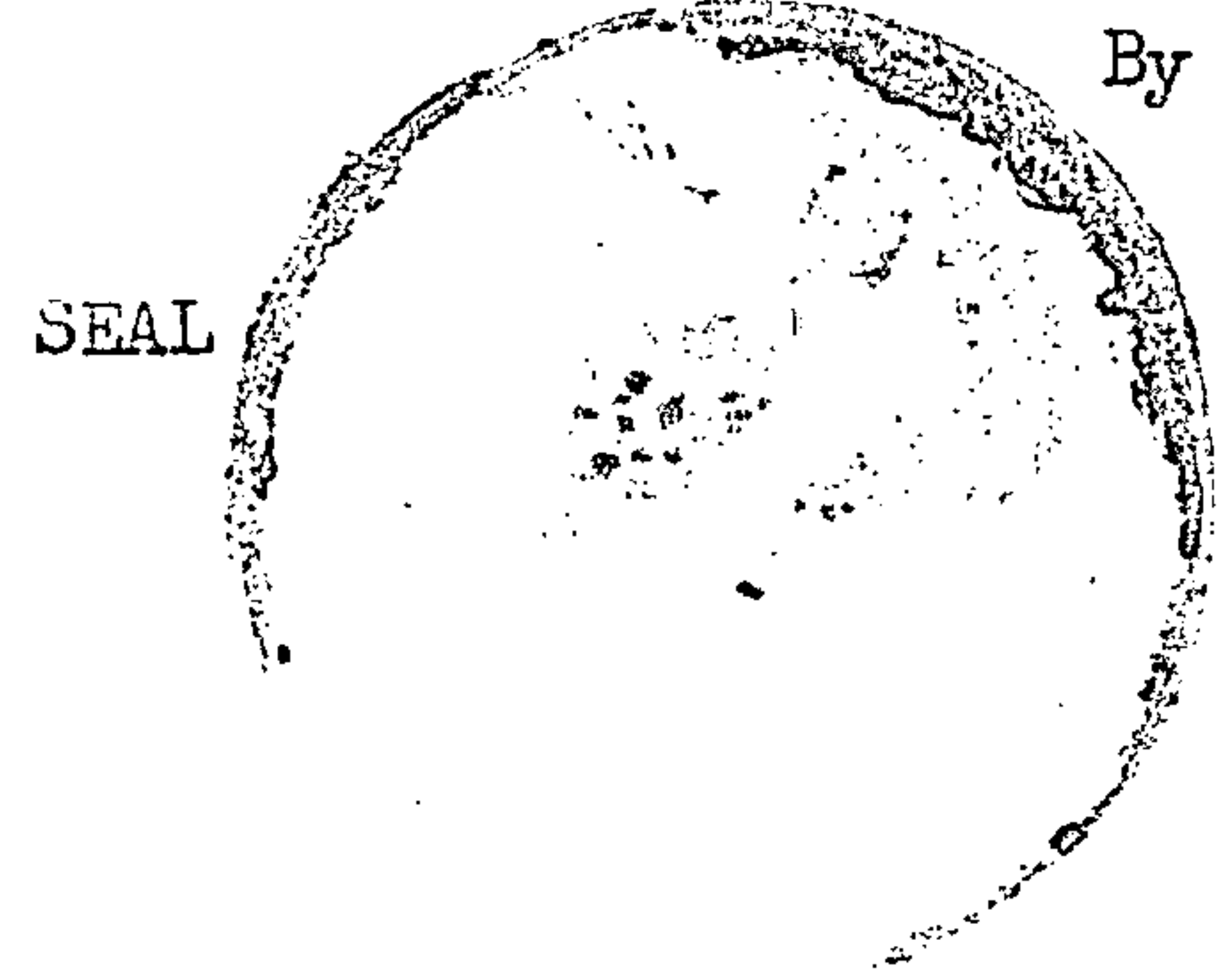
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS Solomon Moore of Shelby County, Alabama has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Solomon Moore according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands" for the West half of the North east quarter of Section Nineteen and South west quarter of the North west quarter of Section Twenty in Township Nineteen of Range Two east in the District of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama, containing one hundred and twenty acres and sixty and three quarter hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tracts have been purchased by the said Solomon Moore.

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, Have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Solomon Moore, and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Solomon Moore and to his heirs and assigns forever,

In testimony whereof, I, James Buchanan, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
