Whereas *James Earl Davis of Shelby County* has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Tuskaloosa in Alabama* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Calvert Davis*

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the North East quarter of Section Thirty in Township Southern of Range Two East in the District of *Tuskaloosa and State of Alabama, containing Eighty Acres and Twenty-nine and a half Acre* and also *one acre* according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Calvert Davis*

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Calvert Davis and his heirs* the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said *Calvert Davis* and to his heirs and assigns forever.
