To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 77,305 for 40 acres, issued in favor of *John M Morgan, private in Captain Haies' Company Alabama Volunteers Florida War*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the *South West quarter of the South East quarter of Section Nineteen in Township Nineteen of Range Four east in the District of Lands subject to sale at Escalosa Alabama containing forty acres and Seventeen and One fourth Hundredths of an acre*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *John M Morgan*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *John M Morgan and his*

heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, *Franklin Pierce* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.

GIVEN under my hand, at the City of Washington, the *First* day of *August* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *Fifty Four* and of the INDEPENDENCE OF THE UNITED STATES the seventy-ninth.
