whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Celia Turner according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the North East Quarter of section thirty one, in Township nineteen of range two East, in the District of Muskogee and State of Alabama, containing Eighty acres and twenty four hundredths of an acre according to the official plan of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Celia Turner.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Celia Turner, and her heirs the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Celia Turner and to her heirs and assigns forever.
