NOW, THEREFORE, in order to clear the error occasioned by the failure of the said Flora H. White to acknowledge said conveyance generally, and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration in hand paid by the said Virginia Hendrick, the receipt of which is help acknowledged, we, the said Flora H. White and husband Stanley White, do hereby release, remise, quitclaim and convey unto the said Virginia Hendrick, all our right, title interest ar claim in and to the real estate described above.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said real estate, together with the improvements and appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said Virginia Hendick, her beirs and assigns Forever.
