
Before the undersigned authority personally appeared G. M. Arthur, who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says:

I am also acquainted with all that portion of the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of said Section 7, except that part lying South of Spring Branch and West of Yellow Leaf Creek and except also five acres off the West side thereof.

The above described land was by Woodrow Dorough conveyed to J. D. Muse and Maggie Muse by deed dated December 29, 1939 and is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in Deed Book 110 at Page 291. Immediately after the execution of said deed above described J. D. Muse and Maggie Muse went into possession of said property, and remained in the actual, open, notorious, continuous, exclusive, adverse possession of same, living upon it and cultivating portions of it continuously until they deeded it to William J. Ingram by deed dated November 8, 1946, which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 125 at Page 452. Immediately upon the execution of the last mentioned deed said William J. Ingram went into possession of said property and remained in the actual, open, notorious, continuous, exclusive, adverse possession of same, living upon it and cultivating portions thereof down to the present time.
