Whereas, *James M. Clark of the County of Liberty, State of Missouri*
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *St. Louis*
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *James M. Clark*
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for
the East half of the Sec. 16, East quarter of Section eight, in Township thirty-four
of Range twelve East, in the Northwest corner of the Sec. 16, Township thirty-four
of Range twelve East, containing eighty acres and fifty-one hundredths of an acre,
according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said *James M. Clark*
NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several
acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said *James M. Clark*,
the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appur-
tenances, of whatever nature thereto belonging, unto the said *James M. Clark*
and *to his heirs and assigns forever.*
