Before me the undersigned authority in and for said County in said State, personally appeared John H. Lee, who, being first duly sworn on oath says that this affidavit is intended to apply to all of the property owned by D. N. Lee, also known as David Needham Lee, situated in SHELBY COUNTY, ALABAMA, and most of which property is shown on the Survey made by W. R. Walker, Surveyor, on August 2nd, 1951, a Map of which survey will be filed for record in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, and a part of which property is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, and a part in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, all in Township 18, Range 1 West in said Shelby County, Alabama, which latter described property is not shown as to a part thereof on the map made by said W. R. Walker, but is conveyed to Alta Lee and Della Lee by deed dated August 24, 1951.

Affiant further says that D. N. Lee died intestate in the year, to-wit, 1922, and his widow, Martha Lee died in the year, to-wit, 1927, intestate.

Affiant further says that the sole and only heirs at law of said D. N. Lee and Martha Lee, each of whom is over the age of 21 years, and is of sound mind, are the following: John H. Lee, whose wife is Mattie D. Lee; Elizabeth Lee Rowan, whose husband is Walter Rowan; Alta Lee and Della Lee, both of whom are unmarried; David M. Lee, whose wife is Lola Meadows Lee; Joseph M. Lee, whose wife is Linda Lee; Evelyn Lee Baker, whose husband is Arthur Henry Baker.

Affiant further says that Anne Little Lee became vested with the title to an undivided share in said estate by reason of the fact that she was the surviving widow of Robert E. Lee, who died testate in Jefferson County, Alabama, in the year 1947, and devised all of his property to his said widow.

Affiant further says that D. N. Lee and Martha Lee are not survived by any descendant of any deceased child of theirs other than those herein mentioned, nor by any other child of theirs other than those herein mentioned.
