Alpha Lucas, who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says:

I am the surviving widow of A. L. Lucas, deceased, who was the grantee in that certain deed from M. Della Latham, an unmarried woman, dated the 25th day of July, 1919, which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 66, at page 169. There seems to be an error in that deed because the beginning point is described as being the SW corner of Lot Number 15, Block No. 2, Bozeman Survey for Maj. Hardie. The real beginning point is the SE corner of Lot Number 15. The description should be, "Beginning at the SE corner of Lot Number 15, Block No. 2, Bozeman Survey for Maj. Hardie and running North 148 feet and 7 inches to the line between said lot 15 and 16, thence Northwest 42 feet on the line between said lots 15 and 16, thence Southwest and straight across said lot 15 to the line between said lots 15 and 14 for a distance of 120 feet, thence continue Southwest and straight across lot 14 for about 150 feet to the old Montevallo and Centreville road, thence due East, along the North side of said road 200 feet, more or less, thence due North 21 feet to the starting point of Lot Number 15. All the portion of said two lots being in the Town of Wilton, Shelby County, Alabama."

Immediately after the execution of the deed to my husband, A. L. Lucas, we went into possession of said property. There was a house on the property we bought and he and I moved into it with our family and lived upon it continuously down to the time of his death and after his death I have continued to reside on the property and during that time no other person, firm or corporation has advanced any claim to it whatsoever, and said possession has been open, notorious, exclusive, continuous, hostile and adverse.

The description above set forth includes the lot which I and my son and step-son, both of whom are children of A. L. Lucas, deeded to Mr. Gray M. Strother, which lot is a portion of said property and is on the southern side and a part of the land we bought from M. Della Latham. We

still own all that portion of the original Latham lot except the part.
we have sold to Mr. Strother.
