bearing date of the 26th day of September, 1951, and payable

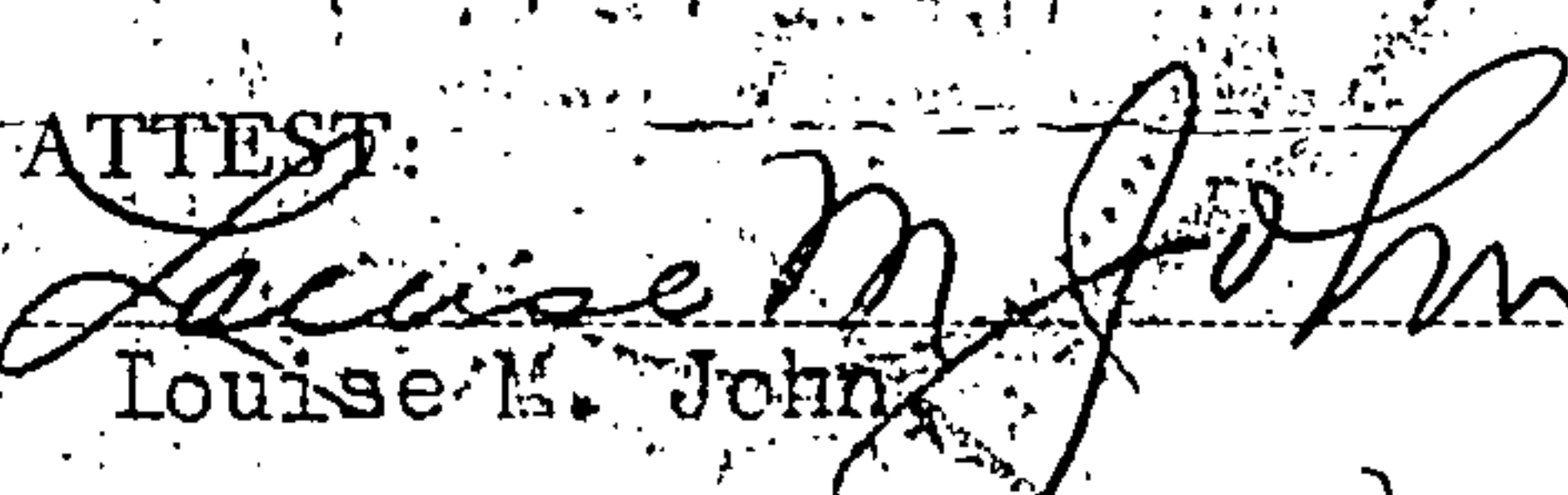
Interest only on said principal sum shall be payable on October 1, 1951. Thereafter

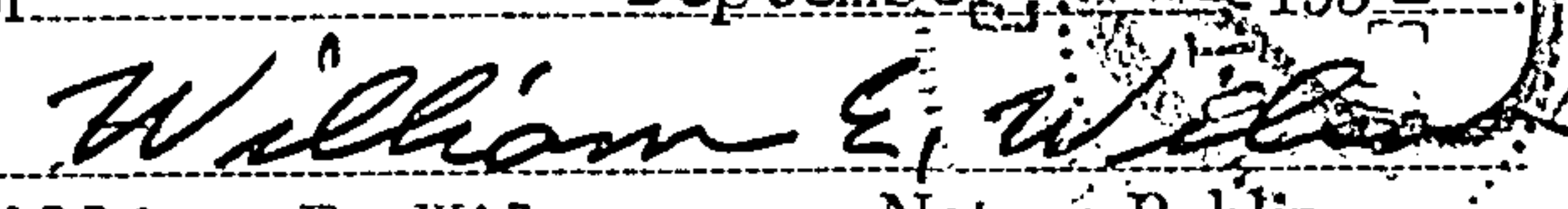
