Personally came and appeared before me, S.A. Lokey, a notary public in and for the State of Alabama at Large, Newman Stone, who after being first by me duly sworn to speak the truth deposes and says:

That he is well acquainted with the following described land, to-wit:

That certain tract of land situated in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, Township 21, Range 1 West, described as follows: Commencing at a point where the Eastern line of the Columbiana-Shelby public road right of way intersects the North line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 36, and run south 21° East, a distance of 438.5 feet to a point on the Western margin of the right of way of said Columbiana-Shelby public road for a point of beginning of the tract herein conveyed: Run thence south 58° 15' West 279.5 feet to a point on the Eastern margin of the right of way of the Louisville and Nashville Railroad Company; run thence in a southerly direction along the Eastern boundary line of said railroad right of way south 24° East, a distance of 370 feet; run thence North 61° 30' East 295 feet to the Western margin of the right of way of said Columbiana and Shelby public road; run thence North 26° 30' West 386 feet along the Western margin of said public road right of way to the point of beginning, and containing 2.49 acres, more or less. Situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

That affiant is a son of George R. Stone, who was in possession of above described land claiming to own it when he died intestate in October of 1932. That soon after the death of my father, the said George R. Stone, Etna Minor and husband Walter Minor, Ethel Carter and husband Lee Carter, Affiant and wife Kate Stone, Nola Shucraft and husband Claude Shucraft, Rutha Wheeler and husband Luke Wheeler, and Ruby Hand and husband Willis Hand conveyed above described land with other lands to Mary Stone, the widow of the said George R. Stone, Caughey Stone, a son of George R. Stone and Esther Stone, a daughter of the said George R. Stone; that the said Etna Minor, Ethel Carter, Nola Shucraft, Rutha Wheeler, Ruby Hand, and affiant, Newman Stone Caughey Stone and Esther Stone/were all the children and the sole heirs at law of the said George R. Stone and

1932, the date of the execution of the foregoing mentioned
