Curlee, recorded in Book 212, Page 425, of the land mortgage records of Shelby County, Alabama, does hereby release from said mortgage (deed of trust) the following:

Begin at a point where the north margin of the Louisville and Nashville Railway intersects the east line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, Township 22, Range 1 East and go thence South 65 degrees 30 minutes west, 840 feet along the north margin of said right of way, thence north 26 degrees 30 minutes west 415 feet, thence south 50 degrees 25 minutes west 319.4 feet to a point on the east margin of the Columbiana-Shelby Road, thence along the East margin of said Road north 11 degrees 43 minutes West 278.3 feet, thence north 83 degrees 45 minutes east, 1,239.0 feet, to the east line of said forty acres, thence south 3 degrees east along the east line of said forty acres 222.0 feet, to the point of beginning.
