The SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 9, Township 21, Range 2 West.



Immediately upon execution of said deed Mr. Miller went into possession of said property and lived upon it and has had actual, open, notorious, exclusive, continuous, adverse possession of it down to the present time, with the exception of the part thereof which he deeded to Della M. Stamps in 1947, which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 128, at page 139.

For a long time I owned adjoining land to the Miller land and have lived around in that section of the country for forty years.
