Before the undersigned authority personally appeared George Miller, who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says:

On the 29th day of March, 1929, Martha A. Naish and others, being the widow and sole heirs at law of James M. Naish, deceased, deeded me the following land situated in Shelby County, Alabama, viz:

The SE 1/4 of NE 1/4, of Section 9, Township 21, Range 2 West.

And the SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 and NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 21, Range 2 West, containing in all 160 acres, more or less.

The above mentioned deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 88, page 175. I went into possession of said land immediately upon execution of said deed and then moved upon it and have lived upon it continuously to the present time. Until about twelve years ago I cultivated portions of it and during all the time intervening from the 29th day of March, 1929, down to the present time I have been in possession of said property claiming to own it and living upon it and during all that while I have had actual, open, notorious, exclusive, continuous, adverse possession of that property except the part I deeded to Della M. Stamps on the 14th day of April, 1947, which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 128, at page 139. I had the same possession of that part of the land as I did the balance but have not had possession of it since I deeded it to Mrs. Stamps.

From the time I obtained title to the property and took possession of it no other person, firm, or corporation have advanced any title to or claim to the same.
