Whereas *Elijah Teague of Shelby County*
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Tuscaloosa in Alabama*
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Elijah Teague*
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the South West quarter section, twenty six, in Township twenty of Range one East in the District of *Tuscaloosa*
and State of *Alabama* containing one hundred and fifty nine acres and thirty two hundredths of
an acre
according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Elijah Teague*

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several
acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Elijah Teague and*
his heirs the said tract above described. To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appur-
tenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said *Elijah Teague*
and to his heirs and assigns forever.
