according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the South West quarter section, twenty six, in Township twenty of range one East in the District of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama containing one hundred and fifty nine acres and thirty two hundredths of
an acre
according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Elijah Teague*



To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said *Elijah Teague and to his heirs and assigns forever.*
