Commence at the Southeast corner of the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 22, Range 2 West, and run thence West, along the South line of said forty 480 feet for a point of beginning, thence in a northwesterly direction to the Northwest corner of said forty, thence in a Southerly direction to the Southwest corner of said forty, thence East to the point of beginning;

Also, beginning at the Northeast corner of SW 1/4 of NW 1/4, of Section 18, Township 22, Range 2 West, and running West along the north line of said forty 480 feet for a point of beginning, and from said point of beginning run West to the Northwest corner of said forty, thence South to the Calera Road, also known as the Spring Creek Road, thence in a Southeasterly direction along said road to a white oak tree near the W. R. Alexander house, thence in a northeasterly direction to the point of beginning;

Also, all that portion in the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 22, Range 3 West, lying north of said Calera Road, less five acres on the West side sold to one Payton;

Also, all that portion of the SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 22, Range 3 West, lying north of said Calera Road.

W. R. Alexander formerly owned all that portion of the SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 22, Range 2 West, lying north of the Calera Road and East and South of my property. There is a lane running in a northeasterly and southwesterly direction between the Alexander property and mine and there is a fence on easter side of the lane and this lane is recognized as the dividing line between the two properties. The Alexander land is now owned by M. L. Smith of Birmingham, Alabama, and we both recognize the lane as being the dividing line between our properties.
