Before me, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Whit Holcombe, who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says:

My father was B. H. Holcombe. He owned a farm on Camp Branch Creek between Calera and Columbiana and that land is in Range 1 West, Shelby County, Alabama. I also knew A. R. Wells and now own his place which is situated between Calera and Columbiana and it is just east of the B. H. Holcombe place and it too is in Range 1 West.

I am acquainted with Louis Casserott. He is my brother-in-law. There is of record in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, a deed from B. H. Holcombe, my father, and wife, Mattie Holcombe, to Louis Casserott, dated March 18, 1925, and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 75, at page 228. I understand that deed described the land conveyed as being in Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama. The land my father deeded to Louis Casserott is in Range 1 West and not Range 2 West and there is evidently an error in the description.

Neither my father, B. H. Holcombe, or A. R. Wells, ever lived near the ~~and never owned any land in Range 1 West~~ Frank Baker Dairy Farm in Shelby County, Alabama. That farm is some ~~twelve~~ miles or more from my father's land, which was his homestead as far back as I can remember, located in Range 1 West, Shelby County, Alabama, on Camp Branch Creek.
