WHEREAS, we the said Bessie Morris Porter and husband Amos Porter are desirous of correcting said error and conveying to the said Milford Lee all the right, title and interest of the said Bessie Morris Porter which was a one-eighth undivided interest as an heir of W.F. Morris, deceased.

NOW THEREFORE for and in consideration of the premises and the further consideration of One and no/100 Dollar to us in hand paid by the said Milford Lee, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we Bessie Morris Porter and husband Amos Porter do hereby remise, relinquish, release, quitclaim and convey unto the said Milford Lee, all our right, title and interest in and to the following described real estate, to-wit:

The Southwest Quarter; the West half of the Southeast Quarter; the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter and the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 12 and all that part of the North half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 19, which lies North of Waxahatchie Creek; Township 24 North, Range 15 East; and the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 13, Township 24, Range 14 East, being situated in Shelby and Chilton Counties, Alabama.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, to the said Milford Lee, his heirs and assigns forever.
