## AFFIDAWIT

My name is J. M. Sorrell. I am the husband of Jessie L. Frost Sorrell, who, along with other persons made a deed to Myrtle H. Wilson on May 8, 1946, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 124 Page 273 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, and which deed covered the following described land:

The SEA of SEA and the southwest diagonal half of the NEA of SEA of Section 1 and the NEA of NEA of Section 12, Township 22, Range 3 West; and also all of the SWA of SWA Section 6, Township 22, Range 2 West; except that part conveyed to Joshua M. Frost, by deed recorded Volume 27 Page 147 of the records in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

On May 8, 1946, the date said deed was signed, George V. Kilgore, being one surviving and the same person as George Kilgore, was the husband of Myrtle Frost Kilgore. She died on October 4, 1935. The said George V. Kilgore had remarried prior to the time said deed was signed and his wife on said date was Roberta Kilgore. Affiant further says he knows of his own knowledge that Myrtle Frost Kilgore did not leave a Will.
