has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *San Francisco*
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *John Day*
according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1830, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
purchase of *Section 11 and 12 of Township 12 North, Range 10 East, in the District of Columbia*, of *Twenty* acres,
and, in range *10 East*, in the *District of Columbia*, of *Twenty* acres, *containing Eight acres of land and Twenty*
acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said *John Day*, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *John Day*
NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have, Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *John Day*
his heirs, assigns, and assigns forever, the said tract above described. To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatever nature thereto belonging, unto the said *John Day*
and to his heirs and assigns forever.
